January 25, 2018

TIP Program/UPWP/CIP:

- Preventative Maintenance (P/M) of CR 59 (Bixby Hill Rd) & CR 2 (Broughton Rd) – Bixby Hill Rd. complete and project is under budget for design and construction. Broughton Rd has been awarded and construction expected to begin in May.
- Bennington #14 (Schad Rd) (NY BRIDGE Project) – Right-of-Way is proceeding. ADP comments received from us and NYSDOT. Final bid documents expected soon following ROW completion.
- Preventative Maintenance (P/M) of 9 Bridges – 12 proposals were reviewed and scored. Labella Associates was chosen as the preferred consultant. Agreement on agenda.

Local Road Projects:
(Road Maintenance)

- Continue cold patch on various county roads as weather permits.
- Continue boom mowing on Town and County Roads.
- Completed removing debris at inlet/outlet at various bridge and large diameter culverts.
- Continue snow and ice removal.
- Continue Winter Dispatch.
- Continue ditching on Wiscoy Rd.
- Completed tree removals at various bridge locations for upcoming 2018 work.
- Completed snow blowing on Town and County roads in Covington, Castile, Orangeville and Arcade.

CIP:

- Completed hauling of add stone for Simmons Rd CIPR.

Local Bridge Projects:
(Bridge Maintenance)

- Completed gravel bar removal on Burrough Rd. Bridge.
- Completed precasting 4'x8' box culverts.
- Continue precasting W-Blocks (retaining walls).
- Began precasting 5'x13' 3 sided culvert for Warsaw #32.

Work for Others:

- Completed House Demo (subcontracted) at 15 N. Main St in Castile. The site needs to have topsoil and seed in late spring of 2018.
- Completed saw cut in road for the Village of Warsaw for a water main break.
- Completed a sign study for the Town of Arcade.
