Chairman of the Wyoming County Board of Supervisors, Jerry L. Davis, reports: “Wyoming County Community Health System has launched its Telehealth Solutions. Wyoming County Community Health System’s (WCCHS) highest priority is the safety and health of its patients and staff. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, they have adjusted their approach to care and are pleased to bring the benefits of telehealth solutions to their patients.

Through phone and internet solutions, providers can conduct virtual care visits in real-time without requiring individuals to leave their homes. The technology enables convenient, online access to care for patients using a telephone, smartphone, iPad, or computer (with a camera).

To make a digital health appointment, simply call the primary care offices and make an appointment. Once the appointment is scheduled, a text message or email will be sent to you that contains a link to your appointment. Click the link at the time of your appointment and virtually see your provider.
