Chairman of the Wyoming County Board of Supervisors, Jerry L. Davis, reports: As of earlier today, Tuesday, April 14, the Wyoming County Health Department reports there are thirty-six (36) lab-confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of 2 cases from Monday, April 13.
