Davis has created a Re-Start Wyoming Task Force which has begun meeting and working toward a countywide strategy and developing a plan to manage the next steps in the recovery and restart process. Chairman of the Wyoming County Board of Supervisors, Jerry L. Davis, reports: As of earlier today, Wednesday, May 13, the Wyoming County Health Department reports seventy-four (74) lab-confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is no increase from Tuesday, May 12.
