Chairman of the Wyoming County Board of Supervisors, Jerry L. Davis reports extending the State of Emergency which will remain in effect through 11:59 PM on July 13, 2020. A copy of which is attached to this press release.

As of earlier today, Thursday, June 11, the Wyoming County Health Department report eighty-four (84) lab-confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is unchanged from the last reported increase on Monday, June 8.

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STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION EXTENSION

Chairman of the Wyoming County Board of Supervisors, Jerry L. Davis hereby extends the Wyoming County State of Emergency which was declared on March 15, 2020, at 12:00 a.m., in response to Coronavirus-19 (COVID-19), which the World Health Organization designated as a world-wide pandemic.

Wyoming County continues to maintain active COVID-19 confirmed cases and has initiated a phased re-opening approach. The threat of the virus remains a concern of local officials and impacts on human needs continue to remain a priority for county and community organizations. Wyoming County must ensure a proactive approach to address any unforeseen public health, public safety or human needs threats as a result of the virus.

All orders and directives issued pursuant to the March 15, 2020, State of Emergency Declaration shall continue and are hereby renewed.

Local emergency orders may be enacted subsequent to this declaration to protect life and property or to bring the emergency situation under control.

This State of Emergency Extension will remain in effect for a period not to exceed thirty days or until rescinded, whichever occurs first. This State of Emergency may be extended for additional periods not to exceed thirty days.

This State of Emergency Declaration Extension is hereby effective on June 14, 2020, at 12:00 a.m. and shall remain in effect until 11:59 p.m. on July 13, 2020.

As the Chairman of the Wyoming County Board of Supervisors, I, Jerry L. Davis, exercise the authority given me under Article 2-B, Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, for the purpose of procuring goods and services, and to render all required and available assistance to municipalities and school districts that is vital to the security, well-being, and health and safety of the citizens of Wyoming County.
