Chairman of the Wyoming County Board of Supervisors, Jerry L. Davis, offers the following statement as we head into the holiday weekend, “Enjoy this Labor Day weekend safely, with friends and family, especially important as we head toward school re-opening next week. Thank you for your ongoing support in making difficult choices and sacrifices to keep our Wyoming County residents safe. The next COVID-19 update will be provided on Tuesday, 9/8 unless there is an unexpected event, in which case information will be shared over the weekend. Be well.”

As of earlier today, Friday, September 4th, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one hundred twenty (120) lab-confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is unchanged from the last reported increase on Monday, August 31st.
