**PRESS RELEASE**  
**September 10, 2020 @ 2:00 p.m.**

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Vice Chair, **Rebecca Ryan**, reports, as of earlier today, Thursday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one hundred twenty (120) lab-confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is unchanged from the last reported increase on Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup>.
