Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. This is an increase of two (2) from the last reported increase on Thursday, October 08, 2020.

Although the Health Department is working over the weekend and on the holiday, regular reporting will resume on Tuesday. If there are significant developments over the weekend, an update will be issued.
