#### How can I get a COVID test in Wyoming County?

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of earlier today, Monday, December 07, 2020, the Wyoming County Health Department reports five hundred ninety-one (591) lab-confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of forty-three (43) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, December 04, 2020.

**yoming** County is experiencing widespread community transmission of COVID-19. Please wear face coverings, maintain social distance, practice good hand hygiene and do not be around others if you are sick.
