From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

NEW: There will be a Moderna COVID-19 vaccination clinic on Thursday, March 4th at Wyoming County Highway. NYS has mandated this clinic be for <u>essential workers in Priority Population 1B</u> and <u>adults with preexisting conditions</u> who are eligible according to New York State Priority Population groupings (HERE). Essential employees being vaccinated must bring proof of eligibility to the vaccination site. This could be an employee ID card, a letter from an employer or affiliated organization, or a pay stub. Those with pre-existing conditions must legally attest to eligibility.

An appointment is required in order to be vaccinated. Register <u>HERE</u> or visit <u>www.wyomingco.net</u> and choose "COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Registration" under *County Quick Links*.

NEW: There will be a Pfizer COVID-19 vaccination clinic on Tuesday, March 9th at Wyoming County Highway. This clinic will be for residents of Wyoming County, aged 65 years and older. Registration will be announced soon at www.wyomingco.net by choosing "COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Registration" under County Quick Links.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Wednesday, March 3, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand one hundred thirty-three (2,133) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of ten (10) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, March 2, 2021.
