**NEW:** Beginning this week, all New Yorkers 18 years of age and older are eligible to receive the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.

Appointments are available for a COVID-19 Moderna vaccination clinic for those who live, work or attend school in Wyoming County. The clinic will be on Wednesday, April 7 from 12:45pm to 4:30pm at the Wyoming County Highway Department.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Monday, April 5, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand three hundred fifty-five (2,355) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of twenty-six (26) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, April 2, 2021.
