New York State Training ID

If you have a State ID number but do not know what it is:

1. Go to the following web address. Type in: <https://lmsportal-dhses.ny.gov/acadisviewer/login.aspx>
2. Click on **Retrieve Your NY ID**, lower left of the home page (circled in red).
3. Enter your last name and email address on the next page you're taken to.
 - a. **If the system does not recognize your name and/or email address**, you'll need to fill out and submit a student data form to request a Training ID. You can do this by clicking on **Web Forms** (upper right of the home page, under Resources – circled in green).
4. On the page you're taken to, click on the first form offered, as shown here:
5. Fill out the form and submit.

You will be contacted via email as soon as an ID has been issued to you.
