WYOMING COUNTY'S PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF TWO NEW TOWERS, AND THE REPLACEMENT OF ONE EXISTING TOWER

Wyoming County is proposing to construct two new 300' towers. One proposed tower is to be built in the Town of Wethersfield, adjacent to the existing 400' tower at the Wyoming County Fire Training Center. The second proposed new tower to be constructed in the Town of Perry. The replacement tower is in the Town of Middlebury to replace an existing 100' tower with a 260' self-support structure.

Antenna Structure Location Information

1. Wethersfield Rd, 500' west of Fire Training Center
Description: 300' Self-support tower.
2. Kennedy Rd, 100' West of Route 39, Town of Perry
Description: 300' Self-support tower.
3. Kelly Hill Rd, 500' west of Kingsley Rd, Town of Middlebury
Description: 260' Self-support tower.

Proposed Marking and Lighting

An aeronautical study revealed that the structures do not exceed obstruction standards and would not be a hazard to air navigation provided the following condition(s), if any, (are) met:

“As a condition to this Determination, the structure is to be marked/lighted in accordance with FAA Advisory Circular 70/7460-1 M, Obstruction Marking, and Lighting, a med-dual system-Chapters 4,8(M-Dual),&15.”

No Federal agency is taking responsibility for the environmental review. However, a complete Environmental Assessment Form (EAF) has been filed with the respective Towns involved, and the Town Boards have approved the EAF.
