**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan**, reports, as of earlier today, Wednesday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one hundred ninety-six (196) lab-confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of two (2) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, October 27, 2020.

Many Wyoming County families are planning for the upcoming holiday season, beginning with Halloween. The Wyoming County Health Department is sharing guidance from the NYS Department of Health on how to take part in Halloween celebrations in ways that reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19.
