Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, **Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of earlier today, Tuesday, December 08, 2020, the Wyoming County Health Department reports six hundred twenty-one (621) lab-confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of thirty (30) cases from the last reported increase on Monday, December 07, 2020.

W Wyoming County is experiencing widespread community transmission of COVID-19. Please wear face coverings, maintain social distance, practice good hand hygiene and do not be around others if you are sick.
