**PRESS RELEASE**  
**January 11, 2021**

**From the New York State Department of Health:** If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

Those eligible in the Phase 1A and 1B Priority Populations are encouraged to register online at <https://apps.health.ny.gov/doh2/applinks/cdmspr/2/counties?OpID=50501100> for COVID-19 vaccination clinics in Wyoming County. Check back frequently at [www.wyomingco.net](http://www.wyomingco.net) as more clinics are added by the County Health Department each week, based on the supply of vaccine from New York State. It is expected that pharmacy locations and physician practices in Wyoming County will receive vaccine directly from New York State in the coming days and weeks. New York State estimates it may take up to fourteen weeks to vaccinate everyone eligible in Phases 1A and 1B.

Individuals must provide proof of eligibility at the vaccination clinic (i.e. a paystub or employer issued ID tag showing they are a member of the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population).

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Monday, January 11, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand four hundred forty-five (1,445) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of sixty-seven (67) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, January 8, 2021.
