**From the New York State Department of Health:** If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health "[Phased Distribution of the Vaccine](#)" guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

The Wyoming County Health Department COVID-19 vaccine clinics for the week of January 11, 2021 are fully booked. More clinics will be announced when additional vaccine is received from New York State. Check back frequently at [www.wyomingco.net](http://www.wyomingco.net) for updated information. It is expected that pharmacy locations and physician practices in Wyoming County will receive vaccine directly from New York State in the coming days and weeks to vaccinate those that are eligible.

New York State estimates it may take up to three months to vaccinate everyone eligible in Phases 1A and 1B. Yesterday, New York State announced a further expansion to the eligible priority population, which now includes individuals age 65 years and older.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Wednesday, January 13, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand four hundred eighty-two (1,482) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of twenty-two (22) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, January 12, 2021.
