From the New York State Department of Health: If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

The Wyoming County Health Department COVID-19 vaccine clinics for this week are complete, with 900 first doses of Moderna vaccine administered through today. More clinics will be announced when additional vaccine is received from New York State. Check back frequently at www.wyomingco.net for updated information. It is expected that more locations in Wyoming County will receive vaccine directly from New York State in the coming days and weeks to vaccinate those that are eligible.

It may take up to three months to vaccinate everyone eligible in Phases 1A and 1B based on supply of vaccine.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Friday, January 15, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand five hundred sixty-eight (1,568) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of forty-seven (47) cases from the last reported increase on Thursday, January 14, 2021.
