From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination. [HERE](#) is a current list of locations in Wyoming County that are registered with New York State as vaccine clinics; appointments are subject to vaccine availability on a weekly basis.

If you received your 1st dose of Moderna vaccine on January 12, 13 or 14 at the Wyoming County Highway Department, watch for an email from the Health Department scheduling the time and date of your 2nd dose of vaccine.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Monday, February 1, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand eight hundred eighty-three (1,883) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of twenty-five (25) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, January 29, 2021.
