**From the Wyoming County Department of Health:**

If you received your 1<sup>st</sup> dose of Moderna vaccine on January 12, 13 or 14 at the Wyoming County Highway Department, you should have received an email from the Health Department scheduling the time and date of your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of Moderna vaccine (check your SPAM folder).

***IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED AN APPOINTMENT FOR YOUR SECOND DOSE, SEND AN EMAIL WITH YOUR FULL NAME AND DATE OF 1<sup>ST</sup> VACCINATION TO [health@wyomingco.net](mailto:health@wyomingco.net).***

If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination. [HERE](#) is a current list of locations in Wyoming County that are registered with New York State as vaccine clinics; appointments are subject to vaccine availability on a weekly basis.

The Health Department received 200 doses of vaccine this week. Instructions from NYS are very specific: 100 doses will be used to vaccinate residents and employees of Office of Persons with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD) congregate care homes in Wyoming County. The remaining 100 doses will be used for education employees in Priority Population 1B and healthcare workers in Priority Population 1A.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Wednesday, February 3, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand eight hundred ninety-eight (1,898) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of six (6) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, February 2, 2021.
