From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

Beginning February 15, 2020 adults of any age with certain pre-existing conditions will be eligible to be vaccinated. [HERE](#) is a current list of locations in Wyoming County that are registered with New York State as vaccine clinics; appointments are subject to vaccine availability on a weekly basis.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Tuesday, February 9, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand nine hundred fifty-six (1,956) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of two (2) cases from the last reported increase on Monday, February 8, 2021.
