From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

Beginning this week, adults of any age with certain pre-existing conditions will also be eligible for a COVID-19 vaccination. The Health Department has been allocated 200 doses of Moderna COVID-19 vaccine this week; a clinic will be scheduled upon receipt of vaccine and according to the most recent guidance from NYS.

The next testing clinic will be Thursday, 2/18/21 between 10:00am and 12:00pm.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Tuesday, February 16, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand twenty-seven (2,027) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of thirty-four (34) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, February 12, 2021.
