From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

If you are a member of Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

[Here](#) is a current list of locations in Wyoming County that are registered with New York State as vaccine clinics; appointments are subject to vaccine availability on a weekly basis.

There are reports of older adults being targeted by scams involving COVID-19 vaccination appointments. A caller will offer to assist in making a vaccine appointment for a fee. The caller will gather personal information to “register” the person and provides a false appointment at an actual vaccine site. No one should ask for money to set up COVID-19 vaccine registration. A call or an email from someone saying they can provide an appointment for money is a scam attempt.

Free COVID-19 rapid testing will be available by appointment at the Health Department each week. Register for an appointment [HERE](#) or by visiting www.wyomingco.net and choosing “COVID-19 Testing Clinic Registration” under *Quick Links*.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Friday, February 19, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand forty-two (2,042) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of six (6) cases from the last reported increase on Thursday, February 18, 2021.
