**From the Wyoming County Department of Health:**

**NEW:** There will be a COVID-19 Moderna vaccination clinic for those that are eligible to be vaccinated and either live or work in Wyoming County. The clinic will be on Wednesday, March 24 from 1:00pm to 4:15pm at the Wyoming County Highway Department. According to updated guidance from New York State, this clinic is **for anyone currently eligible for COVID-19 vaccination** per NYS Guidance [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#). Beginning tomorrow, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, this now includes those ages 50 years and older. Essential workers being vaccinated should bring proof of eligibility to the vaccination site. This could be an employee ID card, a letter from an employer or affiliated organization, or a pay stub.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Monday, March 22, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand two hundred sixty-six (2,266) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of eighteen (18) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, March 19, 2021.
