**From the Wyoming County Department of Health:**

**NEW:** A few appointments remain for the next COVID-19 Moderna vaccination clinic for those that are eligible to be vaccinated. The clinic is on Thursday, March 25 from 8:30pm to 4:15pm at the Wyoming County Highway Department. Register now if you are eligible!

This clinic is for anyone currently eligible for COVID-19 vaccination per NYS Guidance [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) including those ages 50 years and older (new as of 3/23!). Essential workers being vaccinated should bring proof of eligibility to the vaccination site. This could be an employee ID card, a letter from an employer or affiliated organization, or a pay stub.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Wednesday, March 24, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand two hundred seventy-six (2,276) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of four (4) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, March 23, 2021.
