NEW: Beginning today, all New Yorkers 18 years of age and older are eligible to receive the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.

Appointments are available for COVID-19 Moderna vaccination clinics on Wednesday, April 7 from 12:45pm to 4:30pm AND Thursday, April 8 from 8:30am to 4:30pm at the Wyoming County Highway Department.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Tuesday, April 6, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand three hundred fifty-seven (2,357) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of two (2) cases from the last reported increase on Monday, April 5, 2021.
