NEW: According to NYS Health Commissioner, Dr. Howard Zucker, “Today the CDC and FDA issued a statement recommending a pause in the use of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine out of an abundance of caution. New York State will follow the CDC and FDA recommendation and pause the use of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine statewide immediately today while these health and safety agencies evaluate next steps.” Visit [HERE](#) to view the full statement from the CDC and FDA.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Tuesday, April 13, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand four hundred twenty-three (2,423) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of four (4) cases from the last reported increase on Monday, April 12, 2021.
