Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, **Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Thursday, April 15, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand four hundred thirty-nine (2,439) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of nine (9) cases from the last reported increase on Wednesday, April 14, 2021.
