NEW: There will be a walk-in COVID-19 community vaccination clinic on **Friday, July 23, 2021 from 9:00am to 12:00pm** at the Wyoming County Health Department at 5362 Mungers Mill Road, Silver Springs (approximately 2.5 miles south of the Village of Warsaw). Johnson & Johnson vaccine will be available. The single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine is for anyone 18 years and older.

Please bring identification and proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, there is no charge. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 with questions.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, July 22, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand seven hundred eighty-eight (2,788) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of five (5) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, July 15, 2021. There are four (4) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County as of today.
