NEW: There will be a walk-in COVID-19 community vaccination clinic at the Health Department on:

Monday, August 9th from 12:00pm noon to 3pm

The Health Department is located at 5362 Mungers Mill Road, Silver Springs (approximately 2.5 miles south of the Village of Warsaw). Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson vaccines will be available. The two-dose Pfizer vaccine is for anyone 12 years and older; the 2nd dose will be Monday, August 30th from noon to 3pm. The single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine is for anyone 18 years and older.

Please bring identification and proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, there is no charge. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 with questions.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, August 5, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand eight hundred eight (2,808) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of thirteen (13) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, July 29, 2021. There are currently nine (9) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County. The Centers for Disease Control characterizes COVID community transmission in Wyoming County as “Moderate” between July 28 and August 3, 2021.
