NEW: Vaccination Clinics

There will be Pfizer community vaccination clinics on Monday, August 16th & Wednesday, August 18th from 12:00PM to 3:00PM at the Wyoming County Health Department Fair booth.

On Monday, August 23rd 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM there will be Pfizer community vaccination clinic at the Attica Public Library.

Pfizer vaccine is for anyone 12 years and older. Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver that can provide consent.

Please bring identification and proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, there is no charge. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 with questions.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, **Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Thursday, August 12, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand eight hundred eighteen (2,818) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of ten (10) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, August 5, 2021. There are currently eight (8) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County. The Centers for Disease Control characterizes COVID community transmission in Wyoming County as “Moderate” between August 4 and August 10, 2021.
