**NEW: Vaccination Clinic**

There will be a Pfizer community vaccination clinic Tuesday, September 7th from 12:00PM to 3:00PM at the Wyoming County Health Department. Pfizer vaccine is for anyone 12 years of age and older. Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian that can provide consent. Please bring identification and proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, there is no charge. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 with questions.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Thursday, September 2, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand eight hundred eighty-eight (2,888) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of thirty-two (32) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, August 26, 2021. There are currently twenty-six (26) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County.

The Centers for Disease Control characterize COVID community transmission in Wyoming County as “Substantial” between August 25 and August 31, 2021.

Currently, the CDC suggests transmission mitigation strategies that include the wearing of face masks for vaccinated and non-vaccinated individuals indoors and in public settings. The community should continue to promote behaviors that prevent spread and maintain healthy environments, such as cleaning high touch surfaces, ensuring clean ventilation systems, and allowing for social distancing.
